### Pay Monthly Calling Plans

- O2 Pay Monthly is subject to status, credit-check and the terms of a 12, 18 or 24 month minimum term O2 contract. After connecting or upgrading to a minimum term contract, you're unable to move to a lower priced Pay Monthly tariff for 9 months. After 9 months you can change tariff a maximum of once per month, provided that if moving down a tariff you can only move to the next lowest priced tariff with the same minimum term.
- Pay Monthly handset upgrades are not available until the end of any existing minimum term contract and are subject to signing a new minimum term contract.
- Inclusive minutes on O2 Pay Monthly tariffs cover calls to standard UK landlines (starting 01, 02 or 03), calls to O2 mobiles, other UK mobiles and voicemail access and retrieval. Inclusive minutes exclude calls to all non-geographic numbers (08, 05) which are charged at 20p per minute, except calls to 0871 numbers which are charged at 35p per minute, calls to 07744/07755 numbers which are charged at 25p per minute and calls to premium rate numbers where special charges apply.
- On all £30 and above 24 month tariffs, £35 and above 18 month tariffs and £40 and above 12 month tariffs voicemail menu access and retrieval is included and not decremented as part of your inclusive minutes.
- Inclusive messages include texts sent in the UK to UK mobiles, texts sent from abroad, picture and video messages sent in the UK and abroad. One UK text uses one message. Sending one text message from abroad uses four messages. Sending one picture or video message in the UK or abroad uses four messages. Inclusive messages include texts sent in the UK to UK mobiles.
- Texts sent to international numbers from the UK are excluded from the inclusive message allowance and are charged at 16p, except for customers subscribed to Discount Country or ITS who will be charged at 12p.
- Unused inclusive minutes, data and messages cannot be carried forward one month to the next on any tariffs. Existing customers transferring tariffs will lose any accrued rollover allowance.
- Unless otherwise stated, call prices include VAT, are quoted by the minute, and are charged in one second increments. Each call is charged excluding VAT and then rounded-up to the nearest penny. VAT is then added to the total of all charges on your bill.
- Minimum call charge is 5p for calls forming part of your inclusive allowance.
- Prices are correct at time of going to print but are subject to change.
- Prices shown are for Direct Debit only; different payment methods, if permitted, may incur additional charges.
- Use of the inclusive monthly data allowance is handset dependent. New and upgrading customers taking a BlackBerry® device will not receive a monthly inclusive data allowance.
- From 1 January 2008, video calls will be excluded from the monthly allowance and charged 50p per minute. Video call charges start when the recipient accepts the call, even if the video call subsequently fails, therefore a failed call may be subject to a minimum charge. Video calling is handset and network dependant. Use of 3G is subject to 3G coverage.

### Picture and Video Messaging

- To send picture and video messages a compatible handset is required.
- If you acquire a picture messaging handset from a non O2 source you must inform your service provider in order for Picture or Video Messaging to be set up on the O2 network. Picture and Video Messaging will work in foreign networks with which O2 has a GPRS roaming agreement, subject to coverage.

### International Traveller Service

- ITS Rates are charged in pence per minute rounded up to the nearest penny, and apply all day.
- For calls made abroad minimum charge is one minute, then charged in 15 second increments, rounded up to the nearest penny.
- Calls received while abroad are charged in one second increments, rounded up to the nearest penny.
- The following calls will be charged based on the visited GSM operators published tariffs and billing increments: calls made in the visited country except back to the UK, calls made or received in Jersey, Guernsey and the Isle of Man. A handling charge will be added by O2 after conversion to £ sterling. Call charges will vary depending on exchange rates and minimum call charges may apply.

### O2 Web Bolt On

- The O2 Web Bolt On provides you unlimited use of O2's 3G/GPRS Mobile Data Services for Permitted Uses only for £7.50 per month.
- Permitted Uses are use of your SIM card within a handheld mobile device for the purposes of internet browsing only. Any other use of the O2 Web Bolt On will not be a Permitted Use, including but not limited to:
  - Email;
  - Use with Data Cards or Modems;
  - Instant Messaging;
  - IP Telephony;
  - Point 2 Point file sharing and file transfer;
  - VoIP (e.g. Skype™);
  - Video and TV streaming;
  - Slingboxes; and
  - Use in conjunction with routers.
- O2 reserves the right to impose standard browsing charges for usage at any time if O2 reasonably suspects you of using the service for uses other than the Permitted Uses or abuse of the service, including using an atypical volume of data as compared to normal users of the O2 Web Bolt On, which will normally be less than 200MB of usage within a one month period (termed "fair usage").
- O2 will contact you before charges are imposed for usage other than for Permitted Uses or abuse. In cases of recurrent abuse O2 reserves the right to withdraw the O2 Web Bolt On, in which case O2 is not obliged to offer any alternative replacement service.
- To OPT IN to the O2 Web Bolt On send a free text message containing the keyword "WEB" to 21300 or call free on 2425 from your O2 mobile.
- One month minimum term applies. To OPT OUT send a free text message containing the keyword "WEBOFF" to 21300 at least 48 hours before the next payment is due or alternatively call free on 2425 from your O2 mobile.
- You may OPT IN or OPT OUT of the service at anytime. However the minimum charge per month is the monthly fee for the Bolt On. No refunds will be given.
- Benefits of your O2 Web Bolt On apply to use in the UK only.
- Maximum of one O2 Web Bolt On can be added to your mobile at any one time.
- O2 Web Bolt Ons apply to GPRS WAP and/or i-mode but not Circuit Switched WAP. You must have a GPRS handset and your SIM must be GPRS enabled in order to use the O2 Web Bolt On.
- Please note O2 Web Bolt Ons cannot be used in conjunction with the WAP 500, Browse & Download or O2 Active Browsing Bolt Ons.
- You must have a minimum of 60 pence on your handset balance in order to make a GPRS connection in the UK.

### O2 Web Max

O2 Web Max can be added to an O2 consumer voice tariff or purchased as a stand alone tariff and allows you unlimited use of O2's 3G/GPRS Mobile Data Services for Permitted Uses only. Permitted Uses of O2 Web Max are use of your SIM Card within a handheld mobile device for Internet Browsing and email (excludes BlackBerry® email) and use with a Data Card or Modem. Any other use of the O2 Web Max will not be a Permitted Use, including but not limited to:

- Instant Messaging;
  - IP Telephony;
  - VoIP (e.g. Skype™);
  - Video and TV streaming; and
  - Slingboxes.
- O2 reserves the right to impose standard charges or withdraw the O2 Web Max tariff from you at any time if O2 reasonably suspects you of using the service for uses other than the Permitted Uses or abuse of the service, including using an atypical volume of data as compared to normal users of the O2 Web Max, which will normally be less than 3000MB of usage within a one month bill cycle (termed "fair usage").
- O2 will contact you before O2 Web Max is withdrawn or charges are imposed for abuse. In the event that O2 withdraws O2 Web Max, O2 is not obliged to offer any alternative replacement service.
